Our Story

Markus and Liz Bokisch have been producing award-winning Spanish varietals since the early 2000s. With hearts and heritage of Spain, their inspiration to produce Spanish varietal wines in California began by directly importing budwood from select vineyards in Spain, thus creating Bokisch Vineyards, nestled in the Clements Hills of the Lodi AVA. They began making wine from their estate grown and organically farmed fruit in 2000.

Our Vineyards

Vista Luna is a 140 acre parcel in the Borden Ranch AVA in Lodi, CA. This organically farmed vineyard was originally planted in 2006. The Zinfandel goes to some of the most highly respected wineries in the Napa Valley. The Chardonnay and Petite Sirah are sold to the largest organic winery in the United States.

Our Wine

Harvested September 9th, 2020, this Garnacha Blanca is a true expression of the varietal. Featuring a pale gold color it has brilliant tropical aromas of mango, underripe pineapple, orange blossom, and cherry liqueur. Flavors of Meyer lemon, guava, grapefruit, and anise grace the palate. The finish is long and lingering.
