TASTING NOTES

This Rosado is made in a dry Spanish style. It has complex aromas of guava, strawberry and rhubarb pie. It is refreshing and crisp in the mouth with flavors of raspberry, cranberry juice and a hint of pink lemonade. Rosados are made from red grapes and capture the essence of the varietal stripped down to its bare essentials. Enjoy all summer long and into the fall with grilled pork or roast chicken, or simply sip during a picnic under a shady tree.

ROSADO/ROSÉ WINE FACTS & HISTORY

Rosés have been popular throughout the Mediterranean since time immemorial. Countries such as Spain and France take their Rosés seriously; contrasting the hot, arid summer climate with the wine's cool, crisp freshness. Rosés are also extremely food-friendly, combining graciously with Spanish tapas as well as lengthy, afternoon meals.

GREEN CERTIFICATION

In order for a vineyard to be certified green under Lodi Rules, a grower must monitor and record their farming practices and achieve a minimum, quantifiable score in several categories.
