Our Story

Markus and Liz Bokisch have been producing award-winning Spanish varietals since the early 2000s. With hearts and heritage of Spain, their inspiration to produce Spanish varietal wines in California began by directly importing budwood from select vineyards in Spain, thus creating Bokisch Vineyards, nestled in the Clements Hills of the Lodi AVA. They began making wine from their estate grown and organically farmed fruit in 2000.

Our Vineyards

Located on the west side of the Lodi AVA in the Mokelumne River sub AVA, Mule Plane Vineyard is approximately 1300 feet from the river. Being on the west side, we get a better than most exposure to the delta breeze during the spring and summer months allowing for excellent cooling in addition to the warm days. Makes for great fruit flavors in the grapes!

Our Wine

This is our first vintage of making Old Vine Carignane. We originally brought it in as a blending grape and then couldn't resist bottling it at 100% percent. Featuring enticing aromas of overripe strawberry, candied orange peel, smoky leather, and pipe tobacco, this wine doesn't disappoint. Juicy dark fruit flavors of Bing cherry, strawberry and blueberry are followed by earth secondary flavors of forest floor, green celery, and smoke. It has a long and luscious finish.
