They began making wine from their estate grown and organically farmed fruit in 2000.

Our Wine

This late-ripening variety produces lush, dark wines that have quickly become a fan favorite. One of the 5 noble French grapes, this wine expresses Lodi's versatility. Aged in 100% neutral oak, it is deep, dark, and serious in color - this is quite a wine. Features gorgeous aromas of black licorice, blackberry syrup, allspice, bergamot tea, and ripe peach skin that emphasize flavors of bacon smoke, Spanish vermouth, violet, and baking spices. It has smooth but grippy tannins and a lingering finish.
